### General Business

- **2018 Guild Officers**
  - Nominations are now open for all guild officer positions and will be accepted through November. Julie Elliott has offered to run again as Secretary.
  - Nomination forms can be found on the guild website under the Our Mission tab.
  - We also need committee chairs for the following committees: Education, Hospitality and Location.
  - Voting will occur in January; new officers will take over February 1.
  
- **Guild Dues**
  - The board has recommended increasing the annual dues from \$35 to \$40. The additional funds will be used to support education programs in the coming year.
  - The guild will vote on this issue at the December meeting.
  
- **How New is Modern? Exhibition**
  - Thanks to all who attended the opening on Oct. 27. Approx. 200 people attended – the largest gathering to date at the museum – and the museum board members are thrilled.
  - The museum reminded us that quilts can not be sold at the museum because of their non-profit status.
  - Docent led tours are an option at the museum; call the museum to schedule.
  - The show will be dismantled on Feb. 3. Members with quilts in the show can come to the museum that day to pick up their quilts. Quilts also will be returned to their owners at the February business meeting.
  
- **MQG Charity Quilt**
  - Jonna shared all of the blocks that have been created to date. They look terrific! Thanks to all who are participating.
  - Amy Wade has volunteered to do the quilting in January.
  
- **2018 Meeting Locations**
  - Jonna has secured Fancy Tiger for the following months: January, April, June, August, October and December.
  - The Broomfield Community Center remains an option for the alternate months. The cost is minimal.
  - Shelby asked members to help identify other options. We will discuss any ideas at the December meeting.
  
- **Guild Website**
  - Jonna has offered to create “Get to Know a Quilter,” a new section that will feature members of the guild and their quilts.
  - Members are asked to consider what photos/quilts they would like to showcase. Jonna also will send everyone a questionnaire to be used to create copy to accompany the images.
  - Participation is strictly voluntary.

- Pins will sell for \$10 each. Proceeds will go to the general guild account and will be used to support future educational programs.
